CURRENT POLICY FOR PUBLIC USE OF THE LOG HILL MESA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT FACILITIES DURING THE COVID 19 PANDEMIC

Recently it has come to our attention that several community organizations, who in the past have utilized our facilities for meeting space, were not aware of our change in policy at the onset of the Covid 19 Pandemic. We apologize for the inconvenience and hope this will clarify the reason for those changes.

We at the Log Hill Mesa Fire Protection District are very concerned about the danger posed by the Pandemic, as it could potentially lessen our ability to provide primary wildland and structural fire protection for the residents of the Log Hill Mesa Fire Protection District. We must maintain a healthy cadre of firefighters and support staff to assure our responsibilities are met.

As a result of these concerns, we have made the decision to close our facilities to any public gatherings that may potentially introduce Covid 19 into the interior or exterior work areas, vehicles, equipment and support facilities. We realize that this is a very strict standard, but we operate with a very small volunteer and paid staff and cannot afford to take chances with our community's safety.

When the Pandemic has subsided, we fully intend to allow community organizations to utilize our facilities again. It is very important to us to be a vital part of this community and support all of its members. One exception to this would be a restriction against any use of our facilities for any political purposes, as that use could endanger our 501(C)3 tax status.
