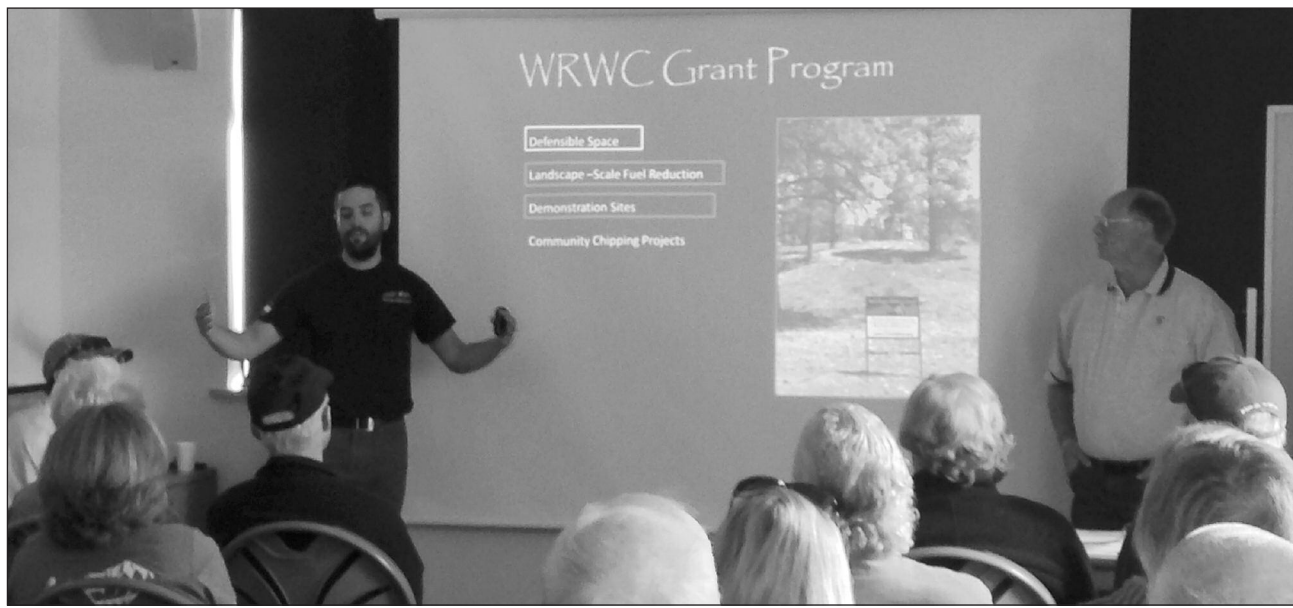


LOG HILL MESA
